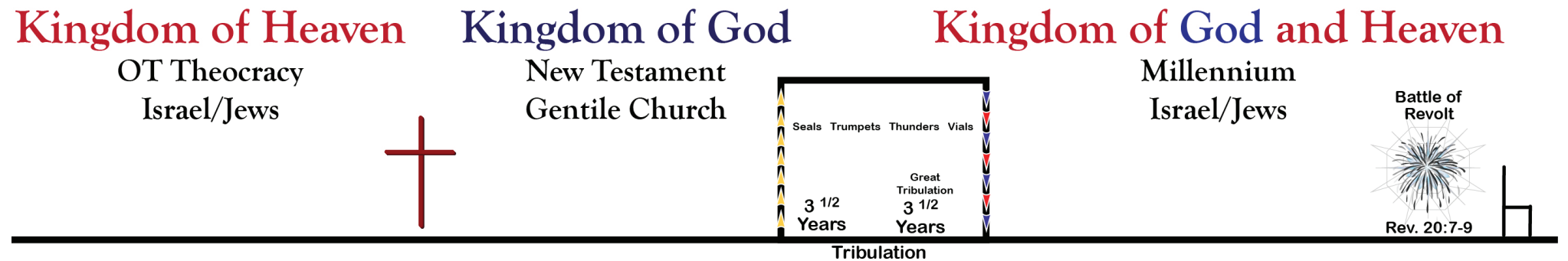


Understanding The Kingdom of Heaven and The Kingdom of God

As God and heaven are not the same (Gen. 1:1), so the kingdom of God and the kingdom of Heaven are not the same. God is a Spirit (John 4:24) and Heaven is a place (John 14:2).

The kingdom of God usually refers to a spiritual kingdom that operates within man (Luke 17:21; Rom. 14:17), but occasionally it is associated with the kingdom on earth (Luke 9:27; Gal. 5:21).

The kingdom of Heaven is a literal, physical, earthly kingdom that has been placed under the authority of many. Both kingdoms will be together in the millennial kingdom of the Lord Jesus Christ (Matt. 6:33; Rev. 11:15).
